Joshua Kids Programs include:

Monthly Empowerment Program:

50-75 Children are bussed in on the third Saturday of each month for, one on one mentoring, provided a lunch, and receive teaching on conflict resolution and character development. Games, prizes, and monthly birthday gifts are also given during our Saturday program.

Summer Camp:

A five day, four night getaway for all 7-12 year olds in our program. Each year 100-120 children get to spend a week outside of their environments experiencing activities at a beautiful campground. Joshua Kids camp includes:

- -Two Daily Character Development Teachings

Children leave our camp forever changed with a new sense of purpose and empowered to take on the challenges they face everyday.

School Supplies/Winter Coats:

During the various seasons we are able to fill in the gaps where the parents of our children are not able to provide. We are able to receive school supplies donations during back to school time and create supply packs for students based on their age group. When it gets cold we are also able to provide the children in our program with coats, hats, and gloves as needed.

Christmas gifts for all children in the program:

Each year in December we receive gift donations from doctors offices, churches, and independent donors. We are then able to separate the gifts by ages and provide over 100 gifts to the children in our program who's families are not able to provide a gift for their child during the holiday season.

Responding to needs of the families of the children in our program:

Throughout the year we receive countless requests from the families of the kids in our program. Many of the requests we are able to accept and assist within the guidelines and various channels we have set in place. We do our best to help with as much as we possibly can and donations to our program allow us to do that. We have been able to help with beds and basic appliances for single mothers, providing dinner and meals for desperate situations, and even providing clothing for the children in our program.
